

CODE OF CONDUCT

Harvard Forest is both a scientific workplace and a field site. It is also a residential site for many people. Diverse work schedules and widely varying activities require the highest personal standards of all who occupy or visit these facilities.

1. Discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, creed, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, national origin, ancestry, age, veteran status, disability, genetic information, military service, or other protected status is antithetical to the goals of the workplace. Discrimination by anyone in the Harvard Forest community will not be tolerated.
2. The Harvard Forest is committed to maintaining a safe and healthy educational and work environment in which no member of the community is, on the basis of sex, sexual orientation, or gender identity, excluded from or denied the benefits of participation, or subjected to discrimination.
3. Harvard Forest is a drug-free campus. Only drugs with a prescription are allowed anywhere on campus.
4. Moderate consumption of alcohol is acceptable for those over the legal drinking age of 21. Binge drinking and intoxicated behavior is unacceptable on Forest property.
5. All forms of scientific misconduct (falsifying data, plagiarism, etc.) are expressly forbidden.
6. All members of the Harvard Forest community, including visitors, are required to behave respectfully to each other and Harvard Forest property.
